**“CAROLE KING: THE LIVING ROOM TOUR 2004-2005”
Summer 2005 concert dates announced**

LOS ANGELES CA, March 16, 2005—Last summer, Carole King embarked on her first concert tour in over a decade. Dubbed “The Living Room Tour,” it was a stripped-down, intimate tour that was well received by concertgoers and critics alike.

King sang her greetings to the crowd, an open and witty piece about what her concert was going to be like called ‘Welcome to My Living Room.’ For the next two hours, she did indeed act for all the world like that’s where she was and that everybody there was her dear friend. That kind of honest warmth is timeless -- and so rare on the concert stage.”

For this six-week North American leg of *The Living Room Tour 2004-2005*, King will be joined by musicians Rudy Guess and Gary Burr. “Rudy makes my musical life better and more fun. He inspires me and pushes me to new heights,” King says of Guess. “Gary is a gifted guitarist and a real singer with a vocal range and purity of tone that matches those of anyone out there,” she adds.

“Carole King: The Living Room Tour 2004-2005” includes “Back by Popular Demand” dates at Wolf Trap in Vienna, VA on July 16 and Chastain Park in Atlanta on July 20. Additional dates to be announced.
